Keyboard Directions

Now you can easily navigate the tables of contents for WestlawNext Canada Texts and Annotations by using your keyboard. For example, Arrow keys will open or close headings and subheadings; or move up, down, or deeper within the table of contents. Enter key will select and follow any links. For additional keyboard navigation instructions, simply click on the question mark icon near the publication title.

Quick start instructions:
Use **Tab** key to move into Table of Contents ("TOC"), then use **Tab** again to leave TOC. To navigate within the TOC, use your **Arrow** keys. Use **Space** to select checkboxes and **Enter** to follow links.

Detailed keystroke navigation instructions:
Once inside the TOC, the following keys provide navigation as described below.

- **Right Arrow**
 - Opens a collapsed heading or subheading one level (does not move focus automatically).
 - **Arrow** again to move into a deeper level of the TOC.
- **Left arrow**
 - When focus is on an expanded heading or subheading, it closes the heading or subheading.
 - When focus is on a subheading that is also either fully expanded or on a collapsed subheading, it moves focus to up one level in the hierarchy.
- **Down Arrow**: Moves focus to the next subheading that is focusable without opening or closing a subheading.
- **Up Arrow**: Moves focus to the previous heading or subheading that is focusable without opening or closing it.
- **Home**: Moves focus to the first heading or subheading in the TOC without opening or closing it.
- **End**: Moves focus to the last heading or subheading in the TOC that is focusable without opening it.
- **Enter**: If the item having focus is a link, pressing **Enter** follows the link; if the text is not link, pressing **Enter** does nothing.
- **Space**: Toggles the selection state of the focused heading or subheading (i.e., checks or unchecks it).
